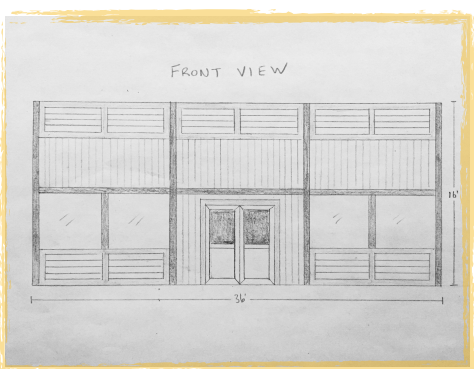

TOP 10 CAMP MOMENTS
