As the rising sun kisses my cheek on the following morning I am awoken by a voice on the wind:

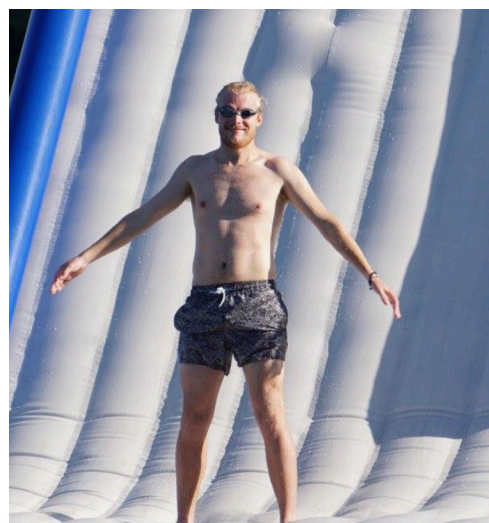
'Buuuudddyyy'
